

Browning Buck Mark Extractor Installation Instructions

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Attention: Before you begin, be certain that the firearm is safe.

Always wear eye protection when working on firearm parts.

Tools you will need:

- A sharp awl, small flathead screwdriver, dental pick, or similar to assist with alignment of springs and parts.
- Optional: a small magnet.

Step1: Pull the bolt back and lock it into place with the bolt stop. The extractor is found along the right hand side of the bolt. Alternatively removal of the bolt may facilitate easier removal of the extractor. Please see the Buckmark manual for removal of the bolt.

CAUTION! Parts under spring tension. Please wear eye protection and perform this step where the plunger and spring will not be lost. Utilize a plastic bag or box for this step.

Step 2: Using a sharp awl, dental pick or similar tool press down on the top of the plunger pressing it toward the back of the bolt. Holding it in place, lift the extractor out of the slot in the side of the bolt. Using a small magnet here can assist with the removal of the old extractor/





Step 3: Pressing down on the plunger with the back of the extractor slide the new extractor into the slot in the side of the bolt. There should be an audible click as the extractor locks into place. The extractor should have good movement as it pivots in the slot.
